Dues:	\$150 a year, can be made in 3 installments; first payment due before YDE Intensive
Tuition:	YDE is 2 additional class hours
Summer Intensive:	Typically early August at the DDC studio

Dancer expectations

Dancers sign a contract and are expected to be at all practices and performances. YDE is a full year commitment. Dancers are representatives of DDC and are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.

Parent expectations

All parents of dancers who are members of YDE are part of the YDE Parent Guild. Parents are expected to help with various events (3-4 per year) such as the YDE Showcase performance, fundraising, Nutcracker food tables sponsored by YDE, and backstage help at various events. Parents who wish to become more involved are invited to be part of the YDE Parent Guild Board.

Summer Intensive

Each summer, DDC schedules an Intensive Workshop intended for YDE members only. During the Intensive, dancers begin to work on new pieces for the coming year. Although it is not mandatory, it is strongly recommended that all YDE members attend. Please understand that dancers who do not attend may not be added to the dances learned so they may not perform in these dances throughout the year. They will be placed in new dances learned throughout the dance year.

YDE members also have the unique opportunity to work with multiple teachers and choreographers in ballet, modern, jazz, tap, and musical theatre dance. These experiences are invaluable for developing their skills and confidence.
